ITEM 1

Discussion was undertaken with respect to Criteria 4 on the Percentage of classrooms and seminar halls with ICT- enabled facilities such as smart class, LMS, etc. It was discussed that the Institute should provide inputs on the number of classrooms and seminar halls with ICT facility (where both LCD and LAN/ Wi-fi are available)

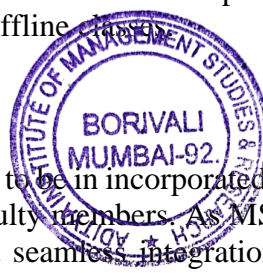
ITEM 3

Discussions were held with respect to Top 10 technology trends that will drive the future of education. The Director mentioned that the Institute is prepared for transition from offline classroom to online learning as MS Teams already existed in the Institute. Dr. Chandramouli Dwivedi insisted on video-assisted learning to be incorporated into the delivery system to make learning more engaging. He also mentioned about students benefit of personalized learning because of customized delivery as the students will get an opportunity to deep dive into areas with assisted learning processes.

It was concluded that learning has become learner-centric and self-paced learning is feasible and online education will stay and will complement offline

Discussion was undertaken on various techniques to be incorporated to be prepared for transition from offline classroom to online learning for faculty members.
